Europe Advance Churchplanting network

Europe Advance is a brand new church planting network for Europe and it is an expression of the Association of Related Churches (ARC) in Europe. ARC is one of the most dynamic church planting networks in the US. Since 2002 ARC has planted over 140 churches. Some of these churches are now among the largest and fastest growing churches in the US.

This CPR will be held in Stenungsund, Sweden, a town about 60 km north of Gothenburg. It will start on Thursday, June 3 at noon and end with lunch on Friday, June 4.

The CPR is for those who are interested in becoming church planters. Their spouses are encouraged to attend. If you are a (future) church planter, it would be advisable for you to have your sponsoring church's pastor attend with you so that he can be fully informed about your vision and Europe Advance's process.

Guest Trainer Pastor Matt Fry

Matt Fry is one of the lead members of ARC (Association of Related Churches) and the Lead Pastor at C3 Church in Clayton and Raleigh, NC. After 13 years in student ministry, God called Matt and his wife Martha to start a new church that would connect with where people are living today. Their passion is to provide "real hope for real people in a real world." C3 Church was launched in an elementary school in 1998 with about 50 people and has grown to several thousand attending on the weekend. The C3 Church Clayton campus is located on an old 47-acre tobacco farm in Johnston County with a 2,000-seat worship center, children and student ministry center, C3 Café and Bookstore. With a passion to train leaders internationally, Matt also serves as an associate trainer with Equip that was started by John Maxwell and has trained over 2 million church leaders around the world.



Church Planters' Roundtable

Planting life-giving churches in post-Christian Europe

3-4 June 2010

Europe Advance will hold its third Church Planting Roundtables (CPR), this time in the Gothenburg area in Sweden. A CPR is an introductory training for people who are interested in becoming church planters in Europe and allows them to find out more about the church planting process of Europe Advance.

Schedule

The meeting begins with Lunch on Thursday 12.00 up till 20.00. We end the evening with dinner together at 20.00. It continues from 9.00 to 13.00 on Friday (Lunch and Dinner included). A guest trainer from the Association of Related Churches, Pastor Matt Fry, and the members of the leadership team of Europe Advance will offer this training and lead the discussion times. You can also stay around for the Sunday and attend a service with pastor Matt Fry in Kristet Center Väst (Christian Center Church) Stenungsund.

The CPR will cover topics that potential church planters will be interested in, such as:

- Where should I go?
- How do I meet people?
- Where is the best venue to get started in?
- How do I finance it...how much do I need?
- Where do I get the information that I need...where can I get the wisdom to do what I need to do?
- How do I get small groups started?
- Leadership lessons for church planters (building teams, communication, etc.)
- Natural Church Development will be presented as a way to measure the "life-giving" principles we embrace.
- and many other subjects...

Registration

The cost for both days is 100 euro (975 skr) per person (the wives of potential church planters attend free of charge) which includes all materials and the meals mentioned earlier. Your registration will be finalized when the payment is received.
