Europe Advance is a new church planting network for Europe and it is modeled on the Association of Related Churches (ARC) in America. ARC is one of the most dynamic church planting networks in the US. Since 2002 ARC has planted over 140 churches. Some of these churches are now among the largest and fastest growing churches in the America. The Europe Advance Church Planters Roundtable (CPR) introduces the church planting process of ARC adapted to the European context. The guest trainer for the CPR is an experienced American pastor.

Located in Mount Pleasant, South Carolina, Seacoast has been recognized as an innovative and influential leader in future strategies for church growth and development.
